Information

Time Difference

During July, South Africa is one hour ahead of British Summer Time.

Visas

Nationals from the UK and EU do not require an entry visa, although clients should check prior to travel that this situation has not changed. You will need 2 consecutive blank pages and 6 months unexpired on your passport.

Climate

South Africa enjoys a temperate and pleasant climate. Although June is winter in South Africa, there is a wide variation in climate between Johannesburg and the coast. Day time temperatures in June vary between 15C and 20C, although evenings can be cool.

Language

There are 11 officially recognised languages spoken, most of which are indigenous to South Africa. However English is spoken everywhere.

Flying Time

The flight from London to Johannesburg takes about 12 hours.

Security

Although South Africa has had bad press in relation to its crime rate, the country has now adopted a zero tolerance attitude to crime. As with any other country, common sense rules apply. Most tourist areas are extremely well policed.

Money

As with travelling anywhere abroad, it is safer to keep the bulk of your money in the form of travellers cheques. Visa and Mastercard are the most widely accepted credit cards, but American Express and Diners are accepted in many places.*

Health

Health requirements are minimal. Most of South Africa is malaria free and tap water is safe to drink. However, we recommend you check with your doctor to see if he suggests anti malaria precautions for travel in the game reserves.
